The 2014-15 operating budget proposes an overall increase of \$61,352 or 1.91% when compared to the 2013-14 operating budget.

2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on Anticipated Revenues, especially service charges and on the general purpose/component unit financial statements. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

On December 1, 2009, the Authority paid the final installment on it's 1993 revenue bonds. The pay off of this debt issue eliminated the requirements for a future debt service reserve and the reserves for renewal and replacements.

Wastewater rates are being reviewed taking into consideration the future use of unreserved retained earnings, future capital requirements and the state of the local economy. Current wastewater user rates are or adequate through fiscal year ending November 30, 2015.

The local economy was in a growth period for many years. This budget and the four prior year's budget anticipated a slow down in the local growth resulting in a lower number of new users. This trend will most likely continue through 2014-15

Unreserved retained earnings will be used to help level future rate increases and fund capital projects
