WHEREAS. East Windsor Municipal Utilities Authority went to public notification to accept bids for the purpose of the purchasing of a Vae/Valve Maintenance Trailer; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 28, 2017, bids were solicited to undertake and complete this work as required by the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, in soliciting bids for said work, the Authority followed the Fair and Open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with a properly advertised Notice to Bidders. One (1) bidder submitted a bid for the provision of the purchasing of a Vac/Valve maintenance equipped trader which was received on October 17, 2017 for a Bid price of \$63,669.00, and

WHEREAS, after review by the Executive Director and it has been determined that the only bidder is responsive to the specifications; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed said Bid and contracts, the Authority has determined that the lowest responsible Bid was for the EH. Wachs Valve Maintenance Trailer model standard LX package with Dimble R2 GPS receiver; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the East Windsor Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- 1. The Chairperson and Secretary of the East Windsor Municipal Utilities Authority are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement, with E.H. Wachs, 600 Knightsbridge ParkwayLincolnshire, Illinois 60069 in an amount not to exceed Sixty Three Thousand Six Hundred and sixty Nine dollars (\$63,669,00) for the purchase of a One (1) E.H. Wachs Valve Maintenance Trailer model standard LX package with Trimble R2 GPS receiver.
