Minutes of Regular Meeting Thursday, February 16, 2017

The regular monthly meeting of the East Windsor Municipal Utilities Authority was held on Thursday, February 16, 2017 at the Administration Building on Wiltshire Drive and called to order by Chairperson Moore at 7:30 p.m.

Chairperson Moore called the meeting to order and read the Public Notice statement announcing that the notice and agenda of this meeting were mailed to the Windsor Hights Herald, Trenton Times and Trentonian on February 10, 2017. An agenda was posted on the official bulletin board of the Authority and delivered to the Township Clerk for posting on the bulletin board at the East Windsor Township Municipal Complex on February 10, 2017. A roll call was taken and Chairperson Moore asked if any Member had an objection to holding this meeting as advertised. No one objected.

Chairperson Moore turned the meeting over to Mr. Brand to begin the reorganization. Mr. Brand requested a nomination for Chairperson and Mr. Miller nominated Linda Moore for Chairperson. Mr. Kurs made the motion to accept and approve the nomination of Ms. Moore as Chairperson. The motion was seconded by Mr. Platizky and unanimously carried.

Mr. Platizky nominated Mr. Lippman for Vice Chairman and Mr. Kurs made a motion to accept and approve the nomination. The motion was seconded by Mr. Platizky and unanimously carried.

Mr. Lawler nominated Mr. Platizky for Secretary and made the motion to accept and approve the nomination. The motion was seconded by Mr. Miller and unanimously carried.

Mr. Millner was nominated for treasurer. A motion was made by Mr. Kurs to accept and approve the nomination, seconded by Mr. Platizky and unanimously carried

Mr. Kurs was nominated for assistant secretary/treasurer. Mr. Millner made a motion to accept and approve the nomination, seconded by Mr. Platizky and unanimously carried.

Before Chairperson Moore started the nomination for professional consultants, she noted that each of the professional consultants had submitted an RFP for the position and Mr. Brand had reviewed the submittals and made recommendations for award. Chairperson Moore nominated Mott MacDonald for the position of Consulting Engineer. A motion was made by Mr. Platizky to accept the nomination of Mott MacDonald for consulting engineer for a term to run until the reorganization meeting in February 2018, seconded by Mr. Millner and unanimously carried.

RESOLUTION #2017-1

Resolution Appointing Hatch Mott MacDonald as Consulting Engineers WHEREAS, the East Windsor Municipal Utilities Authority (Authority) desires to award a professional services contract for Engineering services for 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is awarding this contract under a Fair and Open Process, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, two proposals for these services were received, from Mott MacDonald and Suburban Consultant Engineers and the Authority has determined, price and other factors considered, that it is in the best interest of the Authority to award a contract for engineering service to Mott MacDonald for 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contract Law, N.J.S.A. 40A11-1 et seq. authorizes the award of this contract without public bidding on the basis that the services are to be performed by persons who are recognized as licensed and regulated professionals and are specifically exempted under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the East Windsor Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Authority hereby specifically determines that the procedures followed in connection with award of this contract were in full compliance with the Fair and Open Process for awarding such contracts, as set forth in N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5.
- 2. James Farry of Mott MacDonald is hereby appointed as Authority Engineer until a successor is appointed at the annual reorganization meeting of the Authority to be held in February 2018.

WHEREAS, the East Windsor Municipal Utilities Authority (Authority) is awarding this contract under a Fair and Open Process, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the legal requirements for the Fair and Open Process, the proposal for these services was posted on the Authority's web site; and

Then the water department will inspect and the accounts will be entered into the system for billing.
