Acting Chairperson Lippman requested that the Public Notice be read. The secretary read the statement stating that the agenda for this meeting was mailed to the Windsor Hights Herald and Trenton Times on June 15, 2018. An agenda was posted on the official bulletin board of the Authority and delivered to the Township Clerk for posting on the bulletin board at the East Windsor Township Municipal Complex on June 15, 2018.

Acting Chairperson Lippman asked if there was anyone form the audience present that would like to speak on any issue not on tonight's agenda. Hearing no one, Acting Chairperson Lippman closed the public portion of the meeting.

Acting Chairperson Lippman asked if there were any applications for service. There were none. Acting Chairperson Lippman went on to ask about new business, which brought on the discussion of the facilities report. Acting Chairperson Lippman asked for all in favor to approve the Operating Report for June 2018, all board members were in favor.
