Chairperson Moore asked for update on the water main from Hidden Springs Lane and Disbrow Hill Rd. Mr. Brand stated that the ordered material is being stored by job site and we are expecting to start mid-April. He MUA is doing the work ourselves.

Chairperson Moore asked about the sewer main replacement for Cypress Drive. Mr. Brand said it is finished and was completed by J. Fletcher Creamer.

Mr. Brand gave an update on the dewatering system for sludge at the wastewater plant. He is going on a tour at the lower Twp sewer plant to see the process and to see what the maintenance is and will discuss his findings.

Chairperson asked for an update on the Administration, Maintenance and Water treatment plant. Mr. Brand said per DEP we had to split the project between the admin building and maintenance building, then resubmit for approval to the Dep. We are waiting to hear.

Chairperson asked about the Clarifier rehabilitation at the wastewater plant. Mr. Brand told the board it is in dire need of painting and the mixers need to be replaced. We are looking at approximately \$400,000 and it really needs to be done.

Chairperson Moore asked for information on the Disc Filters. Mr. Brand said the Sand filters are a nightmare. The Disc Filters can handle a lot more and will help meet the new regulations.

Chairperson Moore asked for approval of the payment of bills for March 30, 2025. Mr Kurs made the motion, seconded by Mr. Meixler and unanimously carried.

Chairperson Moore asked for approval of the Operating report from February 2025. Mr. Lippman made the motion, seconded by Mr. Meixler and unanimously carried.

Chairperson Moore requested a motion to approve the Development report for March 2025 Mr. Kohut made the motion, seconded by Mr. Lippman and unanimously carried.

Chairperson Moore requested a motion to approve the Finance Officers report for February 2025. Mr. Platizky made the motion, seconded by Mr. Lippman and unanimously carried.

Chairperson Moore requested a motion to approve the Attorneys report for February 2025-March 2025. Mr. Kurs made the motion, seconded by Mr. Kohut and unanimously carried.
